

ABOUT ROCKHEIM

Rockheim is Norway's national museum of popular music. Our goal is to collect, preserve, and present Norwegian popular music, from the 1950s up until today. The museum forms a basis for experiences and stories, providing insight into music, culture and our society.

Your visit should start in the big box on top of the building. This is the sixth floor, which houses the main exhibition. You can then proceed down, floor by floor. We want you to be active and explorative – don't be afraid to try. Before you leave remember to visit the museum shop.

THE MAIN EXHIBITION

Our permanent exhibition is called *The Time Tunnel*, and works as a journey through modern Norwegian musical and cultural history. From the dawn of a new generation of teenagers in the 1950s, up until the expressions of recent youth culture. Artists, music and instruments are presented in context with the cultural history of the decades.

In these exhibits it is you who operate the playback of sounds, images and music videos – in this manner creating your own stories and experiences.
















5TH FLOOR

Topics of music history and contemporary culture – local, national and international – are explored in greater depth in this ever changing space. A new exhibit is presented once a year on average.


ROCKHEIM **SOUND LAB**
