
ANNO MUSEUMS IN HEDMARK

Did you know Edvard Munch was born in Løten? You will also find the birth home of legendary opera singer Kirsten Flagstad, national museums of women's history, forest, migration, and romani people, art gallery, a wilderness museum, and many more.

ANNO NORWEGIAN EMIGRANT MUSEUM

Stange

• Museum devoted to the history of migration.

- Open air museum illustrates the life led by Norwegian pioneers in the American Midwest
- New exhibition "Unknown landscape" untold stories of emigration and immigration.
- Summer café and idyllic picnic areas, library and archives.
- Open for group bookings year-round.

ANNO DOMKIRKEODDEN **HISTORICAL CENTRE**

Hamar

- Medieval ruins of a cathedral and The Bishop's fortress.
- Exhibitions from the Viking age, the Middle ages and traditional farm life the last 300 years.
- Singing guides Gregorian song and more.
- Pioneering architecture of Sverre Fehn and others.
- One of Norway's largest herb gardens.
- Park at the edge of lake Mjøsa, 60 historical buildings.
- Hamar Medieval Festival every year in June.
- Voted one of the world's most beautiful museums.

- Pilgrim Center The legacy of St. Olav.

ANNO KIRSTEN FLAGSTAD MUSEUM

Hamar

- The birth home of the world-famous opera singer, "The Voice of the century" Kirsten Flagstad.
- See various exhibitions and archives from her life and career.
- Listen to the grand voice surrounded by her family history.
- Norwegian Opera Hall of Fame.

ANNO KLEVFOS INDUSTRIAL MUSEUM / THE MUNCH CENTRE OF LØTEN

Løten

- Klevfos Cellulose & Paper Mill 1888–1976 is a museum and a national industrial heritage site.
- Enjoy an architectural and industrial journey through time. and the process from timber to finished paper.
- Visit "The Cradle of Munch" and learn the story of the world famous painter's relationship with his birthplace and the people there. The artist's bond with Løten was strong throughout his life. The light and the people here greatly influenced his art.

ANNO NORWEGIAN FOREST MUSEUM

Elverum

- One of Norway's most visited museums.
- National exhibitions on forest, forestry, wildlife, hunting, fishing, environment and energy.
- Norway's largest freshwater aguarium.
- Meeting and conference facilities with large capacity.
- Exhibition on cultural historical artifacts.
- Venue for The Nordic Hunting and Fishing Festival every vear in August.
- Norway's official Visitor Centre for Forest
- Accommodation at the museum in forest cottages.
- Mobile home parking.
- Accessibility standard and large free carpark.
- Restaurant "Forstmann"

ANNO GLOMDAL MUSEUM

Elverum

- One of Norway's largest open-air museums with 93 historical buildings from the region.
- Major events: "Living history weekend" and "Night at the museums" (halloween).
- Norwegian building customs and style history.
 National cultural history museum of the Tater/Romani
- Military-, Medical- and Health exhibitions.
- The King's choice from WW2 –1940 exhibition.
- Flavored tour of the museum with traditional food and drinks
- Meeting and conference, can handle large groups.
- Anno Café serving lunch and famous Norwegian waffles.

ANNO TRYSIL OPEN-AIR MUSEUM

Trysil

- Norway's oldest village museum, founded in 1901.
- 21 historical buildings from the forested Trysil area.
- Learn about life and traditions in 18th and 19th century
- Exhibition about the emigration from Trysil to America.
- Guided tours.
- Cafe with space for groups.

ANNO BLOKKODDEN WILDERNESS MUSEUM

Drevsjø, Engerdal

- Exotic and exiting to both children and adults.
- Learn about forestry, log driving, Røros copper works in Engerdal, farming, hunting, fishing, and South Sami culture.
- Open-air museum accessible with wheelchair.
- Visit our Sami activity park for children, and the exhibit hall.





ANNO WOMEN'S MUSEUM NORWAY

Kongsvinger

- The only museum in Norway dedicated to presenting history from women's perspectives.
- Located in a swiss-style villa in Øvrebyen, the charming Old town in Kongsvinger, near Kongsvinger Fortress.
- Unique exhibitions on: the women's movement: tovs and the socialisation of gender through play; abortion and sexuality.
- Exhibition about the bohemian Dagny Juel.
- The museum is accessibility friendly.

ANNO KONGSVINGER MUSEUM

Kongsvinger

- Guided tours in the protected Old Town in Kongsvinger.
- The authentic 1920s apartment of Captain Harald Aamodt and Nina Aamodt
- The exhibition HOMELAND. Erik Werenskiold and Kongsvinger 1855-1905.
- Visit tours in the study of contemporary Kongsvinger author Levi Henriksen
- Within walking distance from The Women's Museum.

In the **Kongsvinger region**, you can visit several interresting and fascinating Anno museums and arenas in **Eidskog** and **Odalen**. The "jewel" is **Skålbergsætra**, a museum seter (outfarm) making exclusive dairy products by hand. Trail walk through the woods are a recomended experience, but the seter is also accessible by car, a few weeks each summer
